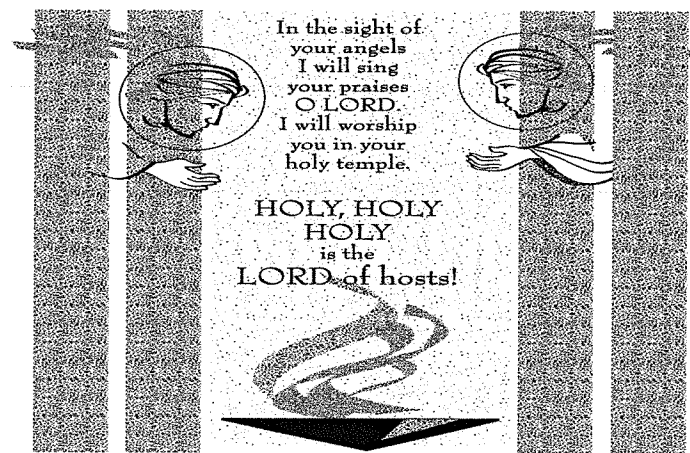


MINISTRY FOCUS
