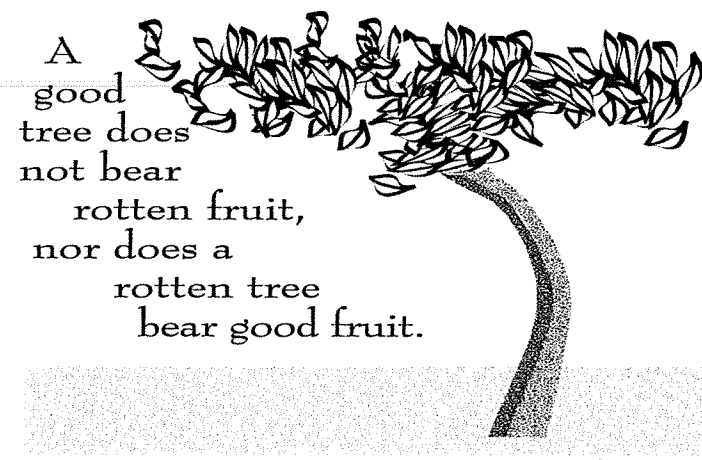

MINISTRY FOCUS

Agape Street Ministries, a Catholic Christian Street Outreach Ministry, reaches out to women involved in prostitution. Dedicated Agape volunteers wear red jackets and are referred to as 'the Candy People' by the women. The volunteers give over 43,000 candy bags a year, each with the message of God's love for them. In addition, birthday bags are provided to the women, as well as small gift bags at Christmas that include basic personal items. A weekly breakfast is provided to over 30-40 women at our Vancouver location. Through encounters with Agape Street Ministries, women learn that God's love for them is unconditional, and it is through Him that freedom and true healing from addiction and sexual exploitation can be realized.
